

COMMITMENT CLAUSE FOR DISPUTE BOARDS

Disputes or controversies arising from or related to this Agreement will be obligatorily submitted to a Dispute Resolution Committee ("CRD", or Dispute Board), which will have its establishment and performance regulated in accordance with the rules contained in the Dispute Board Regulation of the Câmara de Mediação e Arbitragem da Cannabis e Saúde Latino-Americana - CAMACAN LATAM, registered with CNPJ under n°. 40.176.055 / 0001-71, headquartered in the city of Rio de Janeiro, RJ.

The Committee will act [permanently / ad hoc] and will be of the [Reviewer / Adjudicator /
Mixed] type composed of [] member (s) appointed in the form of the Regulation, who will
conduct the procedure in the language [].

The Parties undertake to respect the decisions of the CRD and to use it as an effective mechanism for the prevention, resolution and adjudication of disputes. In no event will the existence of a dispute or controversy give the Parties the right to interrupt the execution of the Contract, with the parties being entitled to appeal [to the Judiciary / Arbitration] in the event of non-compliance with the CRD decision, with the commitment remaining in force respect for the decisions of the CRD and continuity in the execution of the Contract until the [Judiciary / Arbitral Tribunal] issues its decision ".
