



COMMITMENT CLAUSE FOR DISPUTE BOARDS

The parties agree to establish a Dispute Resolution Committee (“CRD”, or Dispute Board), in accordance with the rules contained in the Dispute Board Regulation of the Câmara de Mediação e Arbitragem da Cannabis e Saúde Latino-Americana - CAMACAN LATAM, registered in the CNPJ under nº. 40.176.055 / 0001-71, headquartered in the city of Rio de Janeiro, RJ, for the resolution of disputes or controversies arising from or related to this Contract, and the type of CRD must be defined by the Parties when signing the Term of the Committee of Dispute Prevention and Resolution, in the form of the Regulation.

The Parties undertake to respect the decisions of the CRD and to use it as an effective mechanism for the prevention, resolution and adjudication of disputes. In no event will the existence of a dispute or controversy give the Parties the right to interrupt the execution of the Contract, with the parties being entitled to appeal to the [Judiciary / Arbitral Tribunal] in the event of non-compliance with the decision of the CRD, the commitment remaining in force respect for the decisions of the CRD and continuity in the execution of the Contract until the Judiciary / Arbitral Tribunal issues its decision ”.
